TRANSITION AS A SOURCE OF STRENGTH

The major hormonal transitions in life, the illnesses which accompany these shifts and the homeopathic remedies which aid people during those times will be discussed.

Following human development from childhood to full adult, to parent and to elder, Alize traces the movement from youth to older age, each transition providing an opportunity to feel more completely one's intuition, sexuality and full freedom.

Alize will focus on case analysis and case management, giving equal value to psychological and physical spheres, always encouraging practitioners to follow their intuitions and teaching them to be present for receiving a case with their whole being, including their intuitions.

Case examples will show individuals who have suffered restrictions in their development and have not been able to grow into free adulthood. In these cases we will look for ways to approach the pathologies and the remedies that will free them from these restrictions.

Pregnancy, infertility, abortion, menstruation issues, anorexia, manic depression, menopause, etc. will be covered, including issues pertaining to nutrition and useful supplementation during these various transition periods. Breast cancer and other hormon related cancers will be treated by analysing good cases. Remedies include, among others, Salmon, Folliculinum, Ambra grisea, Lac delphinium and Placenta.

About Alize Timmermann

Alize Timmerman originally trained as a research biochemist. As a biochemical analyst, she published many important papers, journal articles and book chapters. Later, she took a degree in naturopathy, specializing in homeopathy. She has studied intensively with George Vithoulkas and Vasilis Ghegas.

Alize has been in practice since 1980. She began teaching homeopathy in 1986, establishing The Hahnemann Instituut of the Netherlands in the Hague, in 1988. In addition to a full schedule of seminars throughout the world, she teaches a bi-annual weeklong seminar for post graduate students of many nationalities at the Hahnemann Instituut.
